

ZARA GIFT CARD  
GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

1. The Gift Card (hereinafter, the Card) is the property of the issuer ZARA SUISSE, S.A.R.L. (hereinafter, ZARA). The holder of the Card being a mere depository.
2. The Card is exclusively valid in Switzerland to purchase products being sold in any ZARA store or via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com).
3. The price of the Card can be paid by any of the means of payment accepted at the ZARA stores or at [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com). Gift Cards shall not be paid by means of another Gift Card.
4. The return of any Card which has not be used yet shall be accepted, within the following terms:
  - 4.1 Cards purchased at any ZARA store may be returned within 30 calendar days as of the date of purchase.
  - 4.2 Physical Cards purchased via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com) may be returned within 30 calendar days as of the date of the e-mail confirming shipment.
  - 4.3 Virtual Cards purchased via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com) may be returned within 30 calendar days as of the date of dispatch of the virtual Card by ZARA to the intended recipient thereof.

Sale of the above defined different card formats shall be subject to availability in Switzerland.

The price paid for the Card shall be refunded using the same means of payment used to purchase it. For such refund, the original sales receipt or e-ticket and, where appropriate, the payment card and the payment receipt must be presented. The e-ticket is attached to the shipping confirmation e-mail, and is also saved under your account on [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com), and on the mobile App. Return of any Card purchased abroad or at any [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com) website of any other country shall not be accepted.

Remember that any outstanding balance of the Card shall not be refunded, or exchanged for cash.

5. The Card can be used as often as the holder thereof would like, until the total amount has been used up.
6. The remaining balance on the Card shall be the difference between the remaining balance available prior to the purchase, and the relevant amount used up in such purchase. Where the purchase price is in excess of the remaining balance on the Card, the difference may be paid through any payment means accepted at ZARA stores or at [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com), as the case may be.
7. The remaining balance on the Card is shown on the cash register receipt every time a purchase is made with the Card, for purchases made at any ZARA store, or in the information provided upon placing an order, for purchases made via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com). The remaining balance of the Card may be checked at any ZARA store or at [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com).

8. Products purchased with the Card at any ZARA store shall be subject to the general purchase terms and conditions as any other products purchased at said stores. Products purchased with the Card via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com) shall be subject to the purchase terms and conditions shown on said web.
9. Where appropriate, refund for products purchased with the Card which are returned shall be made by ZARA by crediting the price of the returned product back onto the remaining balance of the Card. However, where the Card no longer exists upon return of the products the price of such product shall be credited to a Voucher Card as follows:
  - 9.1 Voucher Card to be handed out in a ZARA store, for any refund for products purchased at any ZARA store.
  - 9.2 Voucher Card to be sent by e-mail, to the e-mail address of the customer who made the purchase with the Card, for any return of products purchased via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com).

Refund methods hereunder provided are an essential term, and as such, they are deemed to be expressly accepted upon purchasing and/or using the Card.

10. The Card purchased at any ZARA store is valid for five years from the date of purchase, the physical Card bought via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com) is valid for five years from the date of the e-mail confirming shipment thereof and the virtual Card is valid for the same period aforementioned from the date of dispatch by ZARA to the intended recipient thereof. At the expiry of the validity period, the Card cannot be renewed, or used to purchase goods, nor shall any unused remaining balance in the Card be claimed.
11. The Card is a bearer instrument. Its holder shall be solely responsible for the use and custody of the Card. The Card shall not be replaced in case of theft, loss or damage thereof. However, ZARA may replace the Card in case of change of format of the Card.
12. Where the virtual Card is purchased via [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com), ZARA shall not be responsible for the non receipt or the delay in receiving such Card by its intended recipient on grounds beyond ZARA's control, including inter alia: (i) the deficiencies or the breakdown of telecommunications lines/systems, (ii) the delay in the transmission of information or data or the loss of information or data which may occur under any of the circumstances provided under letter (i) above; (iii) the inaccuracy of the details of the recipient of the virtual Card provided by the purchaser of the Card, or (iv) the fact that the e-mail sent by ZARA is deemed to be spam or unwanted e-mail.
13. Cards originally obtained through any unlawful means shall be null and void and they shall not be used to purchase products, nor shall the price thereof be refunded.
14. The Card shall not be used for the purposes of advertising or promoting products or services marketed by any third party other than the issuer of the Card, unless prior written consent is given by this latter.
15. The purchase and/or use of the Card entails the full acceptance of these terms and conditions, which have been made available to the customer upon purchase of the Card, and which are also available at ZARA stores and at the [www.zara.com](http://www.zara.com) website. ZARA reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time.
